The natatorium is home to one of Indiana's largest competition pools which includes a ten-lane Olympic-sized aquatic center connected to the existing campus. Hollaender's Structural Glass Railing System with aluminum base shoe and top cap was the perfect combination of railing safety and unmatched sight lines for spectators.



The railing design highlighted the versatility of Hollaender's railing offering. In addition to the Structural Glass System in the spectator viewing areas, the design required the installation of Hollaender's Interna-Rail® system with both glass and wire mesh infill panels, wall-mounted and post-mounted grabrail, as well as exterior clear anodized railing for the entrance stairs and ramp.
